Harquahala Valley Fire District (HVFD) is currently accepting applications for the positions of

Reserve Firefighter EMT/PARAMEDIC

EMT \$10.00 per hour. – PARAMEDIC \$12.00 per hour.

Applications will be accepted from November 20, 2015 to December 18, 2015.

Located west of Phoenix, Harquahala Fire District covers 432 square miles of western Maricopa County. This coverage includes a 20-mile stretch of the I-10 Freeway.

Our team is made up of 12 full-time members aided by paid on call reserves, and two administration members. Harquahala Fire District uses a 48-hour on, 96-hour off rotation schedule with an A, B, and C shift. We are here to ensure the safety and security of those within our district.

Our department handles all medical issues, fires, vehicle extractions, and other calls for assistance as needed within our district.

Additionally, the department serves as needed for backup on large incidents on the mutual aid system.

Minimum Education/Experience to apply:

- High school diploma or general education degree required.
- Must be at least 21 years of age at time of application.
- Current Arizona class D driver's license.
- Firefighter level I & II certification (AZ State/IFSAC/DOD or equivalent).
- Arizona Department of Health Services or National Registry EMT or Paramedic certification.
- Hazardous Materials First Responder Operations Level (AZ State/IFSAC/DOD or equivalent).
- Current CPAT within one year.

Disqualifiers for employment:

- No felonies on record.
- No DUI in past 5 years.

- Applications will be reviewed for completeness, and to determine if the candidates meet the minimum qualifications.
- Written test will be held January 9, 2016.
- Time(s) will be determined based on amount of qualified applications received.
- Oral interviews scheduled to be determined.
- Successful candidates with a minimum score of 70% or better will be placed on a hiring list. Hiring list will be active for a length of 18 months from date of notices to candidates.
