RESERVE FIREFIGHTER RECRUITMENT 2017

Harquahala Valley Fire District (HVFD) is currently accepting applications for the position of:

Reserve Firefighter/Paramedic & EMT.

\$14.00 per hour for Medic - \$12.00 per hour for EMT.

Applications will be accepted from February 1, 2017 to the close of business on March 3, 2017.

The Harquahala Valley Fire District covers approximately 432 square miles and conducts fire suppression and emergency medical operations. Currently operating out of two stations and responding to approximately 350 calls for service annually. The fire district is very involved in community activities and events.

Minimum current certifications requirements to apply:

- Submit a completed HVFD Employment application with copies of all relevant certifications.
- Hold a current Firefighter level I & II certification (AZ State/IFSAC/DOD). *
- Current Arizona State Emergency Medical Technician Paramedic level with appropriate current CPR/ALS certifications. *
- Or current Arizona State Emergency Medical Technician EMT level with appropriate current CPR certification.*
- Hazardous Materials First Responder Operations Level (AZ State/IFSAC/DOD). *
- Proof of current CPAT within one year. *
- Current Arizona class D driver's license. *
- Submit a current copy of 39 month driving record. *
- High School Diploma or equivalent. *
- Resume *
- **Copies of above documents must be submitted with application.**
- ***All required documents shall be submitted to the HVFD Administrative Office prior to the closing date and time.***
- ***All mailed application must be postmarked by the closing date.***

Disqualifiers for employment:

- No felonies on record for past 10 years
- No Misdemeanors for past 5 years.
- More than 8 points against driving record in past 3 years.

Application process will be as follows:

- Completed applications, supplemental documents & resume accepted from February 1, 2017 through March 3, 2017.
- Applications will be reviewed for completeness, and to determine if the candidates meet the minimum qualifications.
- Oral interview scheduled to be determined.
- Top successful candidates with a minimum score of 80% or better will be placed on a hiring list.
